



Borough Juveniles 1st October 2011

On Saturday 1st October 2011 the junior and primary squad swimmers of Edmonton Phoenix competed in the annual Enfield Borough Juveniles Championships at Southbury Road. This is a gala for 8 to 11 year old Enfield Borough swimmers competing in 50m swims for all four strokes and a 100 IM race.

This year saw the largest turnout ever from the Phoenix Squads and there were many brilliant, impressive swims with several swimmers showing excellent potential for the future.

The leading performers on the night were **Meghan Byrne** (age 10) who was joint top girl, taking five out of a possible five GOLD medals and setting 3 new 'Age Group Club' records in the 50 Back (35.65) and also in the 50 fly (34.15) for both the 10 year old and 11 year old girls and **Samuel Pereira** (age 10) who also took five GOLD medals. Samuel won the top boy award with five out of a five possible first places. An amazing achievement for both of these swimmers. Well done!

The 8 and 9 year old girls did exceptionally well with 3 GOLDS for Grace Lennon in Fly, Breast, 100 IM and 3 GOLDS for Alice Comerford in the Fly, Back and Free and SILVER in the 100 IM. 1 GOLD for Athena Andreou (Free) + 1 silver for Lucy DI (Fly) and 1 Silver Nicole DI (100IM)

In the 10 year girls along with Meghan Byrne there were strong swims from Caitlin McCabe with three second places (IM + Back + Free) and Chloe Howe had two second places (Fly + Breast).

In the 8 and 9 year boys we had William McLennaghan with 1 first place (Breast) and 2 second (100 IM, Free) , Hakan Aknar with three second place finishes (Fly, Back, Free), and Aijobe Dudu-Orumens with 2 second places (Fly, Breast)

In the 10 year boys along with Samuel Pereira , we had Callum Dodds who had four second places (Fly, IM, Back, Free), Daniel Gallo with one second place in the breast.

In the 11 year old boys we had one first place GOLD for Ted Winfield in the Fly, two Silvers for Lewis Hitchings (Breast and free and Silver for Beng Ren Siew in the 100 IM.
