



We are pleased to announce that Enfield Swim Squad has now been registered with the ASA and we are delighted to present the new logo. Enfield Swim Squad is an amalgamation of swimmers from the squads of Edmonton Phoenix SC and Griffins SC. There will be two training houses, one on each side of the Borough from Primary/Pre-competitive level up to Senior Squad/Masters level.

The coaches and committees are in the process of negotiating with Fusion to streamline pool time across the Borough to maximise training time for all levels and abilities. This will allow us to create new squads better suited to swimmers' ability levels and ages. Plans for these new squads are in hand and we will be providing further updates as soon as we are able to.

The first stage of the process was to allocate the water time that became available following the closure of Enfield Swimming Club. The ESC members have joined the Griffins house for the time being, some will carry on training in their current sessions and others will gradually be placed in suitable squads in the new Enfield Swim Squad. The Senior Squad has been allocated sessions at Albany Pool on a Thursday and Friday evening while the negotiations with Fusion continue. This is only the first phase of the changes, and the coaches will be looking at all the available pool time to ensure that all swimmers needs are catered for.

Newly appointed Head Coach, Barry Thomas, and his team of coaches will be assessing swimmers in the forthcoming weeks in preparation for the changes that we hope to be able to implement following the completion of negotiations with Fusion.

Our first competition under the new identity will be the Middlesex BAGCATS and Youth in late February/March. We are aiming to have club polo shirts and swim hats available to purchase in the near future and further details will be provided shortly.

We would like to thank everyone for your continued support and enthusiasm in ensuring that the newly formed Enfield Swim Squad becomes a successful and powerful new Swimming Club.
